A very large part of the Panegyri is our delicious and authentic Greek food, but it is our newly installed mosaic iconography that are truly stunning works of art that should not be missed. The church, built in a neo-Byzantine style, is very reflective and authentic of traditional Byzantine architecture. Take a tour and learn about the architecture and traditions of our Eastern Orthodox Christian faith.

Authentic Greek dishes from all areas of Greece will be available for our guests to try and savor. Guests can choose from amazing grilled pork souvlaki or our most popular food item, the Gyro. Both come on a folded pita bread with tomato, onion, and tzatziki, a cucumber yogurt sauce. Full dinner entrees include choices of Pastitsio (a noodle and meat casserole topped with bechamel), Moussaka (an eggplant and potato-based dish topped with a béchamel sauce), Oregano Chicken (bone-in chicken, baked and seasoned with oregano and lemon) or your choice of Tiropita (cheese pies) or Spanakopita (spinach pies), all with rice pilaf, green beans, and a small salad. For a more contemporary option, dine on our Greek Pizza or Yiayia's Small Bites with kalamata olives, dolmathes grape leaves, feta cheese, hummus and pita. Saganaki, flaming cheese is not only entertaining to watch but unbelievably delicious.

There is no better way to top off your meal than with our **homemade** Greek pastries and desserts. From our popular Baklava to our Kourambiethes (powdered sugar cookies), Pasta-Flora (apricot or berry jam filled shortbread); Melomakarona (spiced, walnut cookies), Koulourakia (traditional butter cookie), and our Rizogalo (rice pudding with cinnamon and a hint of citrus). All **homemade** recipes passed down from generations. Made fresh all day long are our Loukoumathes (fried honey puffs) which are perfect for sharing.

Back by popular demand is Ouzo Lemonade, Greek anise-flavored liquor produced from grapes to add a kick to your regular fresh lemonade. In addition, we offer Laconia, a Madtree lager beer made special for our Panegyri, plus a variety of beverages from Madtree as well as Greek and domestic wines and beers.

Live Greek music with the distinct sound of the bouzouki and dance performances of all ages happen throughout the day. Enjoy the artistry and entertainment, as our folk dancers perform in full, traditional, authentic dress costumes. We welcome everyone to join in during the open dancing.
